    - i. New Class/Comp act is out: Act 338 and 339
    - ii. Budget update
      - 1. Same basic pay plan except levels 1 -10 have been raised to meet new minimum wage requirements
      - 2. Midpoints and maximums have all been increased
      - 3. The Provost can now approve up to 15% above minimum without approval from ADHE for new hires
      - 4. Labor market rates may go up with new minimum wage requirements
      - 5. A 1% increase in salary is expected due to new pay plan
      - 6. Board of Trustees will meet in May to discuss pay plan
    - iii. Bill to increase service payments has been presented to the governor: House bill1706
    - iv. Health insurance premiums will be increasing July 1st
      - 1. Classic plan will rise by 1.5%
