- ❖ Permanent closing for lot 71 still to be determined
- ❖ Motorcycles and scooters to be moved to license plate recognition system for Fiscal year 2023
- ❖ Lot 68 off maple has reopened until end of spring, and will be closed in the summer for reconstruction additional parking and pavement
- ❖ A request to go to transit, parking, and traffic committee at the end of March to convert some scooter parking back to car parking.
